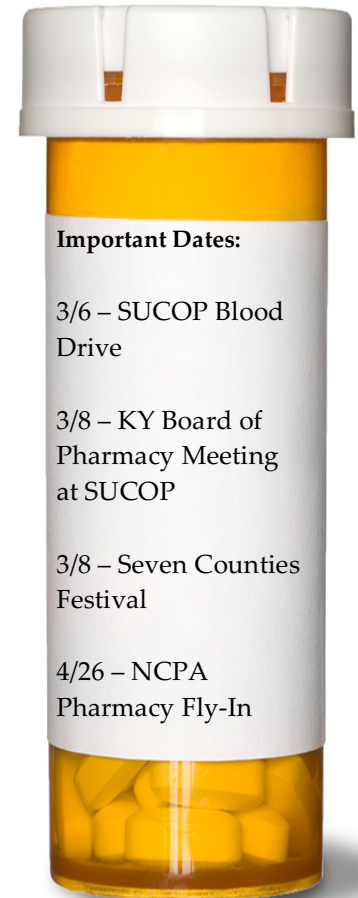


NCPA

Students enjoyed a stress-free day with puppies from Fat Heads Rescue during finals week. Don't miss Puppy Day this quarter, during finals week in March!

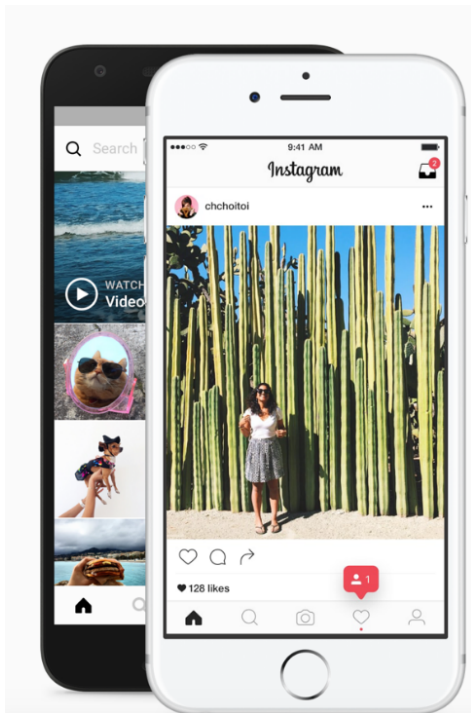
